OTHER QUESTIONS....

What is the MCAT? The Medical College Admissions Test is a standardized test that is administered periodically during the year, but you must take the test no later than early September of the year preceding your application. Since seating is limited in early September, examinees are strongly encouraged to register for test dates in May, June, July or August. The MCAT assesses mastery of basic concepts in biology, chemistry and physics, facility with scientific problem solving, and critical thinking and writing skills. You can take a preparatory course offered by a private company or you may choose to prepare on your own.
