Years 1-2: PRE-Pharmacy at The University of Winnipeg

- Each faculty of pharmacy has its own entrance requirements. To meet the entrance requirements
 for Pharmacy at the University of Manitoba, you will need to complete 48 credit hours, including
 the "Pre-Professional Requirements" listed below.
- Make sure you complete one regular session (September April) that contains a minimum of 24
 new credits of university level degree-credit courses to show you can withstand the rigours and
 discipline needed for this program.
- Students must also attain a minimum Adjusted GPA of 3.0 to be considered for admission.
