Peer Tutoring: Undergraduate students who require academic support while pursuing their degrees can request free 1-1 help with courses, study skills, paper writing, exam preparation, and assignments, from another student. Upon request and when available, the student may be matched with a tutor who speaks the same first language. Book a tutor

Academic Advising: Academic Advising assists with course selection, degree planning, and the academic appeals process, and offers supports for academic success. Students can meet with an Academic Advisor in-person or virtually through scheduled appointments or drop-in sessions.

Mentor Program: This program builds community on campus by matching new, first time students with an experienced student. A mentor can help students adjust to University life and provide peer-peer support through phone, zoom, text, or email, and in-person meetups. Request a mentor

UWinnipeg Immigrant & Refugee Student Club: This student group brings immigrant and refugee students together to support each other socially and academically, create a sense of community, and to act as a voice for immigrant & refugee students on campus.
